On the basis of the duty to inform in accordance with Article 13 of the Basic Data Protection Regulation (DSGVO), we would like to inform you transparently about the processing of your data within the framework of our webinars.

2. the purposes and legal basis of the processing

- Webinar Registration

If you participate in a webinar, we will require personal information (name, first name, email address, time zone). This information will only be used for the purpose of conducting the webinar. For this purpose we will send you an invitation to the webinar to your e-mail address. Your contact information will be used by the organizer (responsible party) to send the webinar content after the webinar has been held. This processing is based on your consent in accordance with article 6 paragraph 1 lit. a DSGVO.

- Newsletter Subscription

If you would like to receive the newsletter offered on the website in order to receive information about other webinars, we need an e-mail address from you as well as information that allows us to verify that you are the owner of the e-mail address provided and that you agree to receive the newsletter. Further data will not be collected or only on a voluntary basis. We use these data exclusively for sending the requested information and do not pass them on to third parties.

The data entered in the newsletter registration form will be processed exclusively on the basis of your consent (Art. 6 para. 1 lit. a DSGVO). You can revoke your consent to the storage of the data, the e-mail address as well as its use for sending the newsletter at any time, for example by clicking on the "unsubscribe" link in the newsletter. The legality of the data processing operations already carried out remains unaffected by the revocation.

The data you provide us with for the purpose of subscribing to the newsletter will be stored by us until you unsubscribe from the newsletter and deleted after you cancel the newsletter. Data that has been stored by us for other purposes (e.g. e-mail addresses for the member area) remains unaffected by this.

3. transmission of data

We may transfer your personal data to other companies, as far as this is permitted or necessary within the scope of the purposes and legal basis described under point 2. This especially concerns the transfer of your information to the regionally based Woodward companies. In addition, your data will be forwarded to the companies involved in the implementation of the webinar. Appropriate data protection contracts have been concluded with these companies. A further transmission of the data will only take place if you have expressly agreed to the transmission or if we are legally or officially obliged to do so.

4. storage of the data

The participants' data will be completely and irrevocably deleted 30 days after the webinar has been held. This does not apply to the consent to the newsletter.

5. what are your rights?

INFORMATION

You have the right to obtain information about your personal data processed by us and to request a copy of this data.

CORRECTION, DELETION, RESTRICTION

In addition, you are entitled to demand that the data be corrected if it is incorrect or to demand that the data be deleted if it is stored in an inadmissible manner. If deletion is not possible - for various reasons - you have the right to demand a restriction of the processing or blocking of your data.

REVOCAATION

Every person affected by the processing of personal data has the right, granted by the European Directive and Regulation Giver, to revoke his or her consent to the processing of personal data at any time.

RIGHT OF OBJECTION

If the processing is based on Art. 6 para. 1 f) DSGVO (balancing of interests), you have the right to object to the processing of this data at any time. We will then no longer process this personal data, unless we can present compelling reasons worthy of protection that outweigh your interests worthy of protection. Or the processing is necessary for the assertion, exercise or defence of legal claims.

DATA TRANSFERABILITY

You also have the right to receive your data in a suitable, common and machine-readable format in accordance with Article 20 DSGVO.
